THREATS

At this time, The UK Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) advises against all travel to Borno State, Yobe State, Adamawa State, Bauchi State, Gombe State, Kano City, rivering areas of Delta, Bayelsa, Rivers, Akwa Ibom and Cross River States, as well as within 20km of the border with Niger in Zamfara State. Several other areas are also listed by the FCO under 'all but essential travel'.

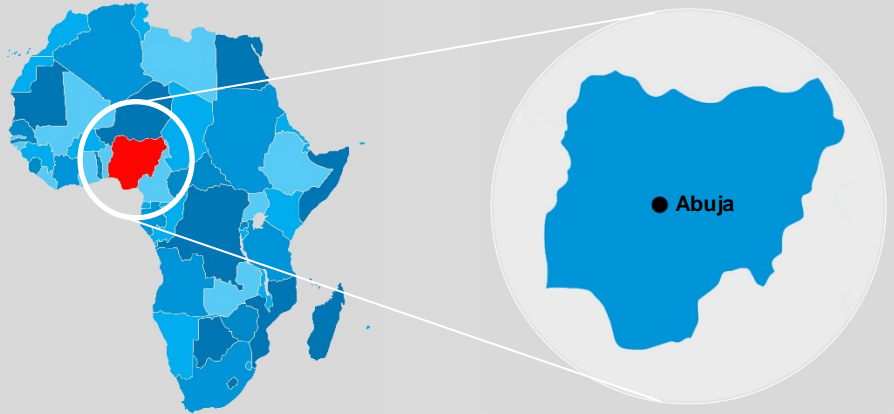
When travelling to/in Nigeria, there is high threat of:

- **Terrorism**
- **Kidnapping**

According to the FCO "Attacks could target public places where crowds gather, including markets, transport terminals, government buildings, security and educational institutions (schools, further education colleges and universities are regular targets), and international organisations." Also targeted, are places frequented by foreigners, such as restaurants, places of worship, bars, shopping centres and markets.

Boko Haram, an Islamic extremist group, is present and carries out regular attacks in northern Nigeria. These attacks occur particularly in Borno, Yobe and Adawa states, where Boko Haram has its operating base.

Due to the present threats in Nigeria, it is widely recommended that you do not travel to this country without sufficient Travel Insurance. Always check your Travel Insurance policy will cover you for high risk locations.
